



#### WELCOME TO THE HERB ALBERS FEEDLOT FOR CATTLEMEN'S BALL 2005!

THE PREPARATIONS HAVE BEEN LONG IN THE PROCESS AND HAVE INVOLVED HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE WHO HAVE SHARED THEIR TIME AND TALENTS TO MAKE TODAY A SUCCESS.

G. Henry Albers, father of Herbert Albers, Sr. Immigrated from Germany in 1885 and settled on a farm 1 mile south of Altona. In 1893, he bought the Pleasant View Farm northeast of Wisner. According to a historical news article in 1914, he had 20 head of cattle on feed and had marketed 60 head during the year. In 1922, his youngest son, Herbert, Sr. began working the family farm. Herbert Sr.'s brothers were also involved in agriculture – owning a dehy plant, farming and raising black angus & polled hereford cattle. In 1962, with 3,000 head of cattle on feed, Herb Albers Jr. followed in the family tradition and returned to the farm, working in partnership with his father until Herb Sr.'s death in 1979. Herb Sr. and Herb Jr. both held many positions in state and national industry organizations. Today, the feedlot has grown in size to 15,000 head, and has undergone many changes since the early days of a few hundred head of cattle and Herb, Sr.'s purebred Hampshire hogs. Basic feeding is orchestrated through a fully-automated feed mill built in 2001; all cattle are tracked daily from their arrival through their ship date; and a manure & waste management program has reduced the amount of commercial fertilizer used in crop production.

KATHY (PEHRSON) ALBERS IS ALSO A NATIVE OF NORTHEAST NEBRASKA. KATHY GREW UP AT LAUREL AND ATTENDED THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA AT LINCOLN. HERB AND KATHY WERE MARRIED IN 1964. THEY RAISED THEIR THREE CHILDREN, JEFF, HOLLY AND MATT, ON THE FAMILY FARM. THE ALBERS CHILDREN ALONG WITH THEIR SPOUSES ARE ALL GRADUATES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA – LINCOLN AND HAVE RETURNED TO THE AREA TO BE INVOLVED WITH THE FAMILY BUSINESSES.

WE, ALONG WITH OUR CHILDREN - JEFF AND ANN, HOLLY AND TODD, AND MATT AND TRISH — AND OUR EIGHT GRANDCHILDREN, DAILY GIVE THANKS TO GOD FOR THE MANY BLESSINGS HE HAS BESTOWED ON US. OUR FAMILY, FRIENDS AND COMMUNITY HAVE ENRICHED OUR LIVES, AS WE HOPE WE HAVE DONE FOR THEM.

IN THE PREPARATIONS OF THE PAST YEAR, IT HAS BECOME EASY TO GET TIED UP IN DETAILS AND LOSE SIGHT OF WHAT JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup> IS ALL ABOUT. THE RESEARCHERS AT THE UNMC EPPLEY CANCER CENTER, THE ONLY NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE-DESIGNATED CLINICAL CANCER CENTER IN NEBRASKA AND THE FIVE STATE CENTRAL REGION OF THE UNITED STATES, ARE COMMITTED TO DISCOVERING THE CAUSES OF CANCERS AND THE FACTORS THAT INFLUENCE A PERSON'S RISK OF GETTING CANCER, AS WELL AS THE DEVELOPMENT OF NOVEL THERAPIES FOR TREATING AND PREVENTING CANCER. 


