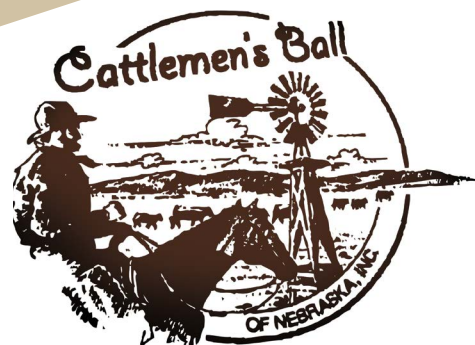

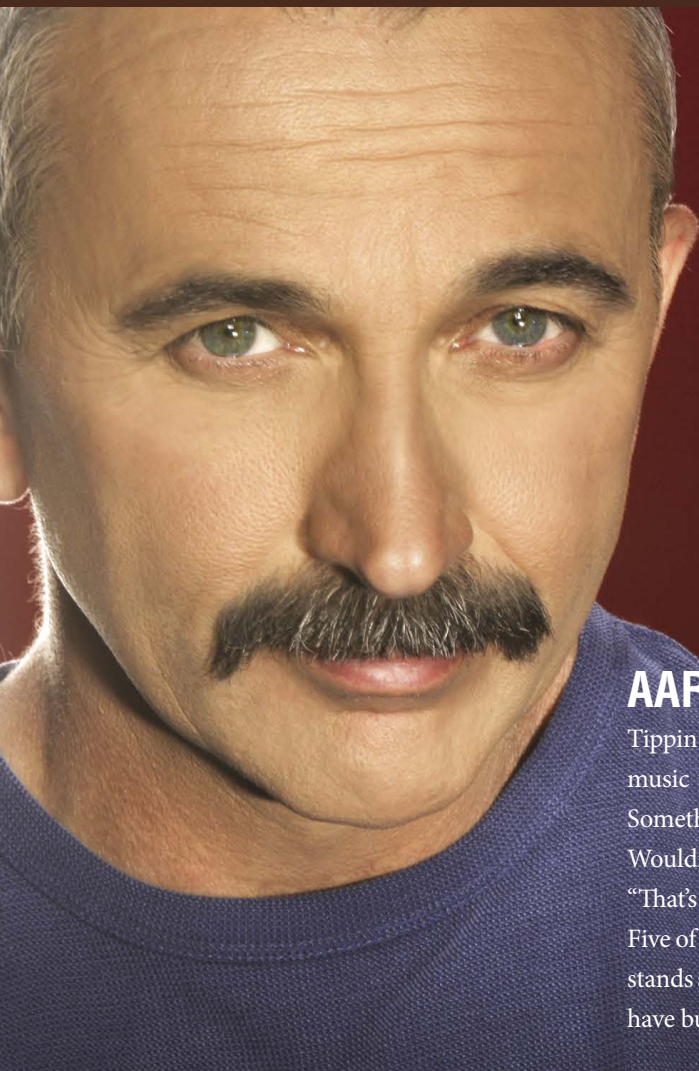

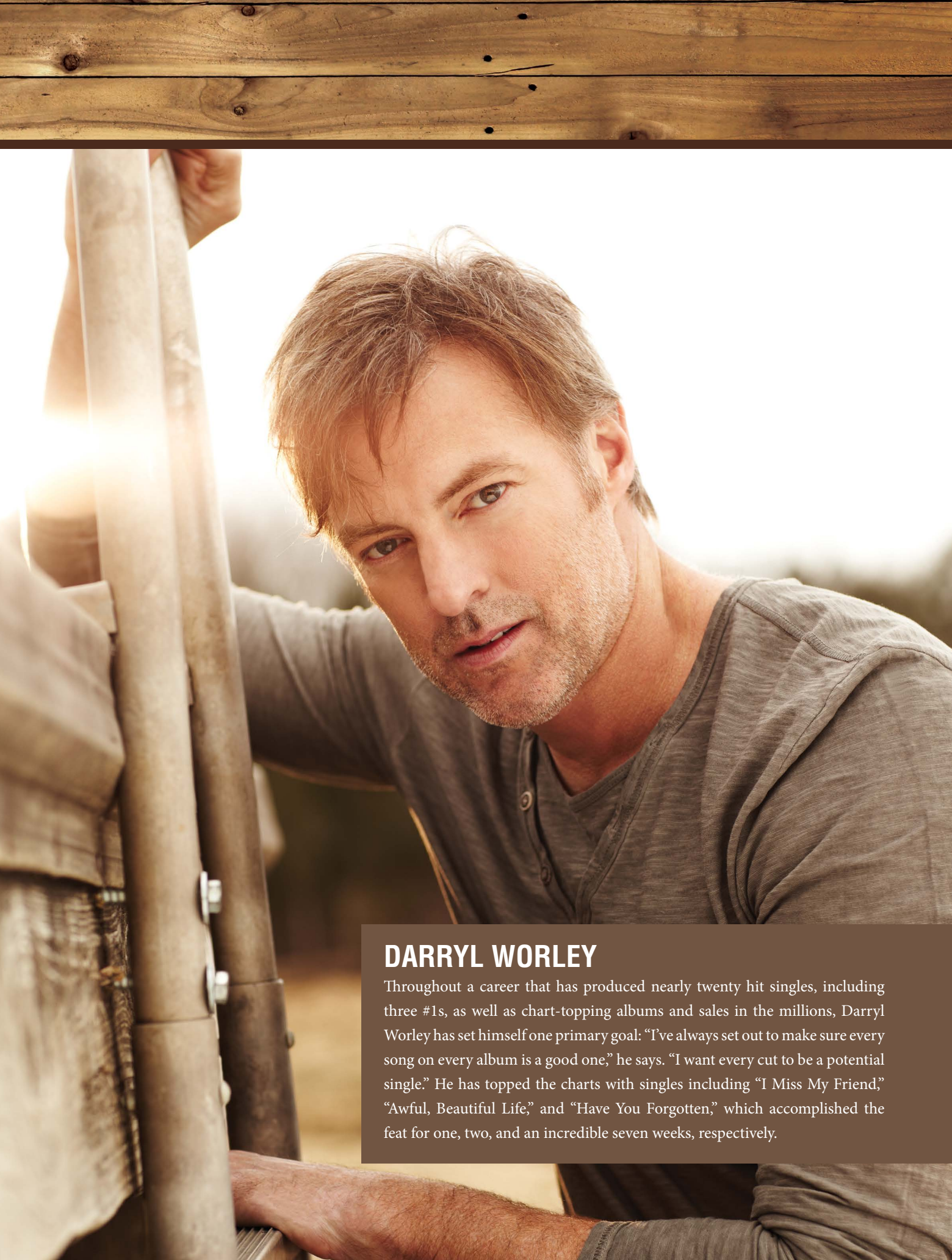
AARON TIPPIN

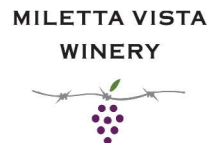

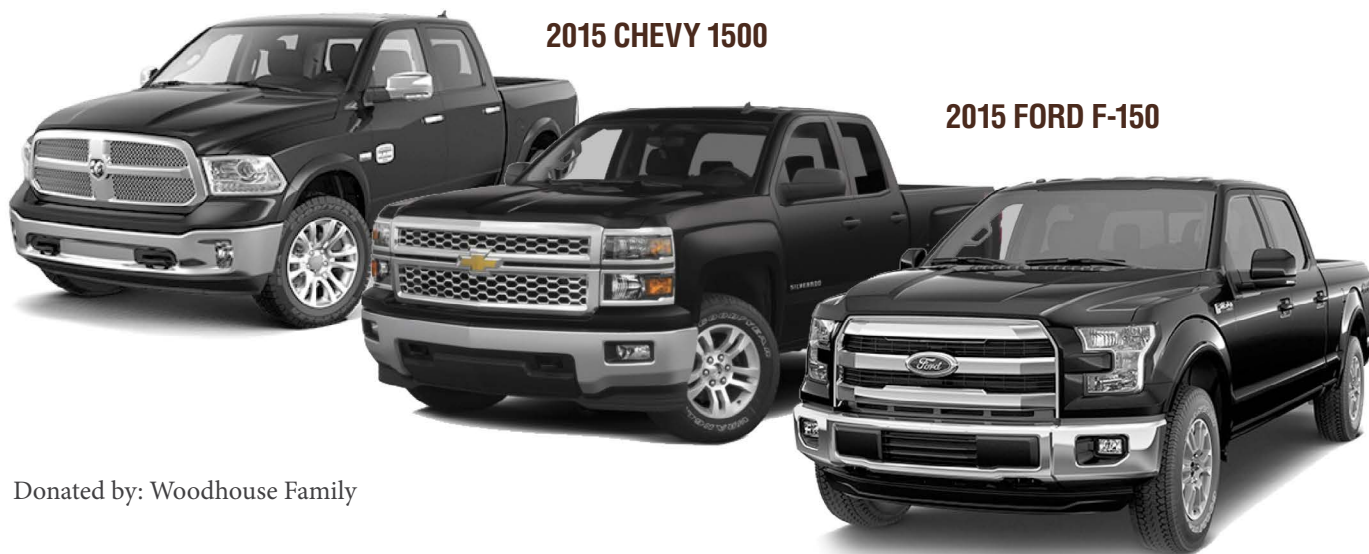

Outlaw Trail

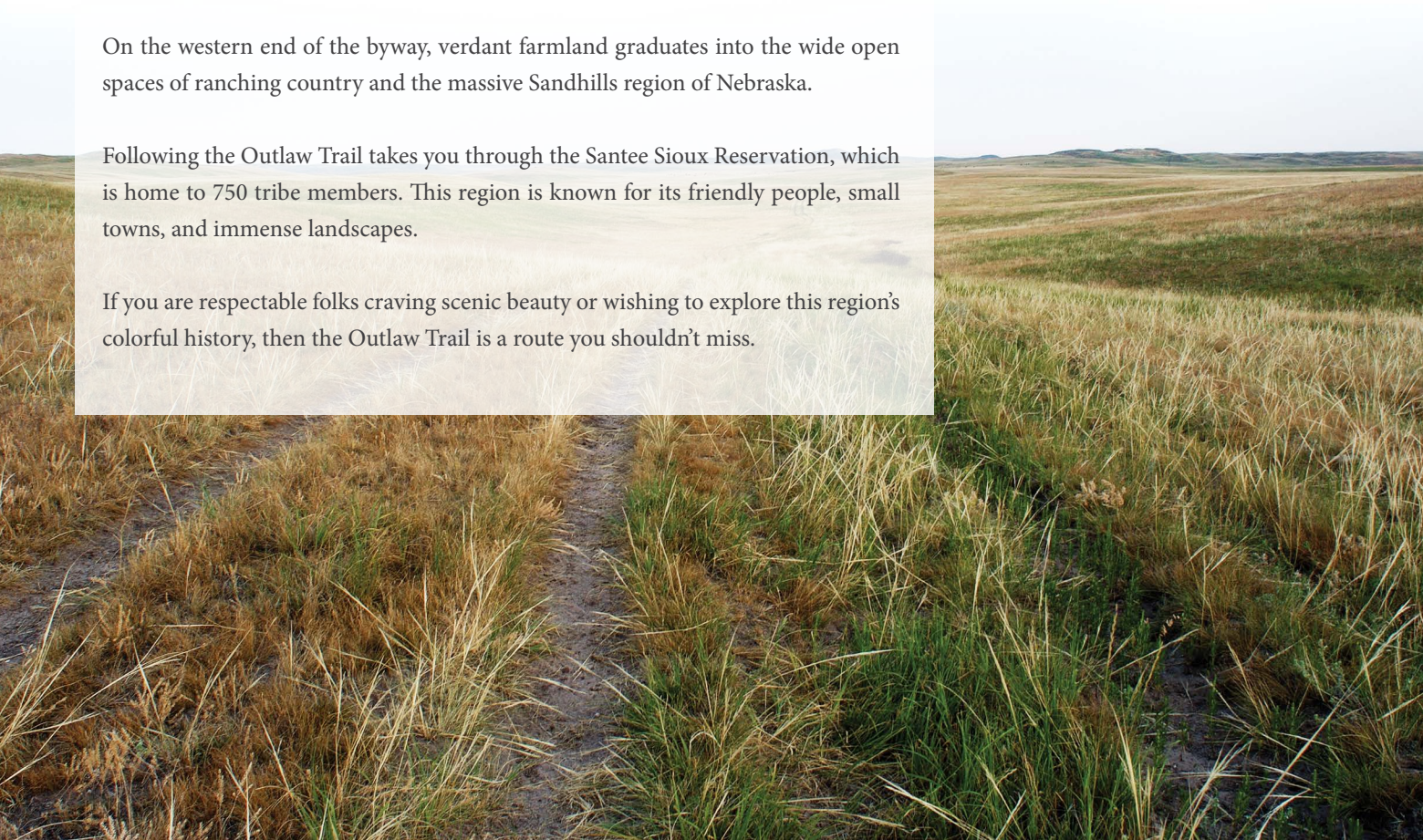
